REGULATION NO. 3

THE ACQUISITION, USE, MAINTENANCE, AND SALE OF, AND ALL
OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION WITH, THE MOTOR VEHICLES
ATTACHED TO THE EXECUTIVE AND JUDICIAL BRANCHES OF THE
GOVERNMENT OF PUERTO RICO

SECTION 1. - This regulation is promulgated in conformity with subdivision (b) of Section 4 of Act No. 49, approved August 4, 1947, as amended by Act No. 163, approved May 12, 1948, which provides:

" The formulation of a plan which will stimulate the employees and officials of the Insular (Commonwealth) Government affected by this Act to acquire private automobiles which they may use to carry out official business on the basis of a compensation system for miles run, and any other forms of compensation which may be reasonable; PROVIDED, that the chiefs of departments and chiefs of divisions shall calculate the miles run on the basis of the official road map of Puerto Rico. "

SECTION 2. - All officers and employees of the Puerto Rico Industrial Development Company heretofore or hereafter transferred to the Economic Development Administration created under Reorganization Plan No. 10 of 1950 who are covered by the automobile purchase plan of the Industrial Development Company shall continue to be covered by the said plan until the plan required by subdivision (b) of Section 4 of Act No. 49, approved August 4, 1947, is promulgated.

SECTION 3. - No officer or employee of the Economic Development Administration may avail himself of the benefits of the said plan of the Industrial Development Company after this regulation is approved.

Regulation No. 3

SECTION 4. - The Economic Development Administrator shall forward monthly to the Chief of the Office of Transportation of the Government of Puerto Rico a report showing the names of the employees covered by the plan, the positions held by them, the sum deducted for amortization of the debt, the amount paid as stand-by allowance, miles run on official business, and the amount paid for the mileage run.
