To amend Section 2 of Article 82 of Regulations Number 6  
of the General Services Administration.

SECTION 1: To amend Section 2 of Article 82 of Regulations  
Number 6, Government Acquisition Regulations to  
read as follows:

ARTICLE 82:- Procedure For Unipersonal and Multipersonal  
Services Rental

1. Unipersonal

.....

2. Multipersonal

Multipersonal services professionals or not shall  
be handled by formal or informal bid, depending on the  
amount involved.

a. Professional Services

Professional services to be rendered by entities or  
professional firms, and related to the functions and  
services rendered by the Administration, such as data  
processing through electronic system, microphotography,  
construction, transportation, printing, printed publi-  
city and other, shall be recruited by formal bid.

1) Exceptions

The multipersonal professional services are exempted  
from a formal bid:

a) When the amount involved does not exceed that  
established in this regulations.

- b) When the Administrator expressly exempts it.
- c) When the law regulating the profession or its code of ethics prevents said professional from appearing in public bids.
- d) When the service is exclusively one of counseling.

SECTION 2: Effectiveness

These regulations shall enter into effect thirty (30) days after their presentation at the Department of State of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, according to the provisions of Public Law No. 112 of June 30, 1957, as amended better known as the "Regulations Act of 1958".

Approved in San Juan, Puerto Rico on the <sup>14<sup>th</sup></sup> day of *January* of 1982.
