FORMAL BIDS REGULATIONS

Amendment of Item 14 of Article 7 to add a paragraph that reads as follows:

Article 7: Bidders Registry

14. Buyer Obligation

Each Buyer or Sub-delegate Buyer issuing purchase orders as a consequence of an informal bid, open market, or emergency purchases or any other acquisition procedure may only issue these orders to requested bidders in the official lists.

In those geographical areas where, for valid reasons, a Bidders Registry shall not be maintained, the purchase order may be followed among those responsible bidders established in such areas.

Effectiveness:

This amendment shall enter into effect thirty (30) days after its presentation at the Department of State of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, according to the provisions of Public Law 112 of June 30, 1957 as amended; known as the "Regulation Act of 1958".
