DELEGATE BUYERS REGULATIONS

Amendment of Item 3 of Articles 42, 43 and paragraph that reads as follows:

By: *Samuel de la Parra*  
to add a .....  
Assistant Secretary of State

Article 42: Procedure Up to Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars

.....

3. Bidder Selection

The Buyer shall select from the Administration Bidders Registry those that according to the need of the moment may be the most practicable ones.

In those geographical areas where, for valid reasons, a Bidders Registry shall not be maintained, the purchase order may be followed among those responsible bidders established in such areas.

Article 43: Procedure Up to Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars

3. Bidder Selection

From the Administration Bidders Registry, the Buyer shall select those that, according to present needs, are the most suited, guided by location and capability criteria.

In those geographical areas where, for valid reasons, a Bidders Registry shall not be maintained, the purchase order may be followed among those responsible bidders established in such areas.

Article 44: Procedure Up to Four Thousand (\$4,000.00) Dollars

.....

3. Bidder Selection

When determining bidders, the Buyer must take into consideration the following criteria:

- a. He shall verify that these bidders are registered in the Bidders Registry;
- b. He shall make sure that they are located near or easily accesible to the place where the Government needs originate; or able to transfer themselves to such place in short notice.

In those geographical areas where, for valid reasons, a Bidders Registry shall not be maintained, the purchase order may be followed among those responsible bidders established in such areas.

Effectiveness:

This amendment shall enter into effect thirty (30) days after its presentation at the Department of State of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico according to the provisions of Public Law 112 of June 30, 1957 as amended, known as the "Regulation Act of 1958".
