REGULATIONS

TO AMEND clause 5, eliminate clause
amend and renumber clauses
and 8 as 6 and 7 of article
81 of Regulations Number 6 of
the General Services Adminis-
tration approved on February
29, 1980, as amended, known
as "Government Acquisition
Regulations"

SECTION 1:- Clause 5 is amended, clause 6 is eliminated,
clauses 7 and 8 are amended and renumbered as clauses
6 and 7 of Article 81 of Regulations Number 6 of February
29, 1980 of the General Services Administration known
as "Government Acquisition Regulations" so that they read
as follows:

"ARTICLE 81.- PROCEDURE TO ACQUIRE CONSTRUCTION
SERVICES UP TO TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000.00)

- 5. Steps to be taken after Awarding
 - a. Award Notice

The selected bidder will be notified lf the
award inmmmediately by telephone and his verbal
notice of acceptance will bind him.

1. Review

These awards will not be subject to
review. Therefore, further procedures
will not be handled under the terms
established for formal bids reviews.

b. Purchase Order

The purchase order must be issued within
fourty eight (48) hours of the informal bid
award.

6. Deliveries

When the construction materials acquired are to be installed or casted upon delivery, or delivered in full or partially at projects, the person in charge of the work will be their Official Receiver, acting under temporary designation will be issued in accordance to a special procedure established by the Administrator. The person in charge of The Regional Office will have to certify his signature in each receipt.

In order to keep the records in order, a copy of each receipt issued will be sent to the corresponding administrative unit.

7. Record

A public record will be faithfully kept of all the informed bid handlings.

SECTION 2:- EFFECTIVENESS

These amendments shall enter in effect thirty (30) days after their presentation at the Department of State of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, according to the provisions of Public Act Number 112 of June 30, 1957, as amended; known as the "Regulations Act of 1958."
