AMENDMENTS TO THE ACQUISITION REGULATIONS

SECTION 1.- Purpose

The Acquisition Regulations of the General Services Administration is amended to include dispositions related to the multiple selection contracts.

SECTION 2.- Amendments

Amendment of Article 87 of the Acquisition Regulations of the General Services Administration to add item 3 to read as follows.

'Article 87.- Types of Contracts

....

3. Multiple Selection Contract

Multiple Selection Contracts shall be awarded with various bidder at the same time, so that the petitionary agencies may issue the orders against the category and bidder that most adequately meets the needs of said agencies.

a. Application


These contracts shall be awarded given the following circumstances:

- 1) When the demand is of such magnitude that it cannot be met by one contractor alone;
- 2) When the variety of types and models of what is requisitioned do not permit the selection of one type of model only for general use;
- 3) When variety is allowed in the budgetary capacity of the agency.'

SECTION 3. - Effectiveness

This amendment shall be in effect thirty (30) days after their being filed in the Department of State of Commonwealth of Puerto Rico as provided in Public Act No. 112 of June 30, 1957, as amended, known as "The Regulations Act of 1958".
